## DID YOU KNOW?



ACE schools have access to the same eLearning courses available to technicians in STARS.



Courses completed by students through the ACE program are **fully transferable to STARS**.



ACE students that hire on at your dealership may have a significant head start towards STST certification.



Transferring ACE training benefits both the dealership and the new technician.



The ACE program is available nationwide.

## ACE to STARS Transfer Process

During the interview, identify ACE students—these candidates would have taken Ford Service Training through their high school or college automotive program.

If an identified ACE student accepts an employment offer, **initiate transfer to STARS by emailing** → [SVCTRN@Ford.com](mailto:SVCTRN@Ford.com)

Subject Line: **ACE to STARS Transfer**

Include the following in the email body:

- New technician's STARS ID
- Dealership P&A Code
- New technician's email address
  - **Must be the email address used to register for ACE, even if it's different from the email address being used for STARS.**
- Request training history to be transferred to STARS.

Transfer is typically completed in 2 business days or less.



The technician's ACE account will be deactivated when the transfer is complete. If the technician is still in school (ex: summer internship or working while attending college), any further eLearning courses will need to be taken in STARS.

# Frequently Asked Questions

<b>What schools can participate in the ACE program?</b>	ACE is offered to both high schools and colleges.
<b>What are the differences in training between ACE and STARS?</b>	eLearning courses offered through the ACE program are identical to the same courses taken through STARS by a technician.
<b>What is the cost to the dealership to transfer credit to STARS?</b>	There is no cost to the dealership.
<b>How do you know if a candidate has ACE training history?</b>	The easiest way is to make asking the question part of your interview process! However, this flyer is provided to all ACE schools - if your candidate has brought it in, that's a good indicator!
<b>Do ACE student hires count towards SOS objectives?</b>	Yes! Sponsoring ACE students from an ACE school that you work with is a great way to work towards SOS objectives.
<b>Are both paid and unpaid SOS students eligible for credit transfer?</b>	No; only paid student sponsorships with a STARS ID are eligible for ACE training history to be transferred to STARS.
<b>Who should I reach out to if I have additional questions?</b>	Your Technical Placement Specialist (TPS).
